4. CARE Registry is coming soon:

The chronic angioedema registry (CARE) is a prospective, international, multicenter, observational (non-interventional), open-ended disease registry being developed and managed by GA²LEN ACARE and UNEV e.V.

The aim of this project is to establish and to run a global registry for all patients with angioedema, i.e. patients with MMAE, BMAE, and other types. The results of the registry will be published and should help to improve the medical care for patients. We aim to have all ACARE centers partake in the CARE registry.

5. Scientific Developments:

>> Hereditary angioedema (HAE) in Belgium: results from a national survey

Van der Poorten et al present the first nation-wide epidemiological study regarding HAE I and II in Belgium. Their data, on 112 patients, show that median delay between first symptoms and diagnosis was 7 years and that the morbidity of HAE is not to be underestimated (51% of patients had experienced pharyngeal or tongue swelling and 78% had experienced abdominal symptoms).

60% of symptomatic patients reported to receive long term prophylactic treatment. Human plasma-derived C1-esterase inhibitor concentrate was used by 56.3% of patients. Knowledge and dissemination of these data is critical in raising awareness, encouraging development of therapies and optimising nationwide management.
